- Please avoid the frustration of arriving at a school activity only to discover that it has been postponed or cancelled. The most sure way of receiving timely and accurate updates from us is via the D6 communicator. Mr Dean Dollenberg (ddollenberg@hatfieldcs.co.za) will offer you any assistance that you need.
- 2019 sees a change in the way we will be delivering reports to pupils. Reports will now be sent from the school electronically and no hard copies will be received unless specifically requested. (The exception to this is the Junior Primary Phase who, for various valid reasons, will receive hardcopies.) This change is more efficient for us and it means that reports go first to the intended audience which is the parent. This brings a change to our December closing; parents will not need to come in and collect reports on 7 Dec. They will be mailed to you then making the final assembly on Wed 4 Dec the last 'thing' of the year for families.
- Should any of your personal details change (e-mail address, phone numbers, residential address etc) change, we ask that you mail admin@hatfieldcs.co.za. This is vital as we sometimes have an emergency situation and cannot contact parents.
- One of the issues that we are trying to rectify on our new system has to do with detention. The current notification does not allow parents to see the reason why detention is being sat.
