

STATIONERY REQUIREMENTS FOR GRADE 3 – 2025

Below please find the list of items that your child will be required to have during the Grade 3 year. It is vital that each pupil has all the required items at school on the **first day** of the term to facilitate the Learning Programme. These items need to be **CLEARLY MARKED** individually (e.g. each pencil) with your child's name. Please remember that the consumables (writing implements, crayons, glue etc.) need to be replaced as and when necessary during the course of the school year. **Spare stationery will be stored in their marked ice-cream container.** All the items listed below are available from stationery outlets: e.g. Pick 'n Pay, Makro, Waltons. **Please use items from Grade 2 that are still in good condition.** PLEASE NOTE – the school executive have decided to purchase exercise books for each student. The reason for this is to standardize as much as possible to ensure the same standard in the grade. The cost for these books has been added to the textbook levy.
